



In honor of St. Patrick and his founding of Christian Ireland, the following is a litany called the sacred **Lorica** he and his followers chanted for protection against the druids.

A beautiful litany to use anytime, especially in this season of prayer!

"I arise today through the strength of heaven; light of sun, radiance of moon, splendor of fire, speed of lightning, swiftness of wind, depth of sea, stability of earth, firmness of rock.

I arise today through God's strength to pilot me; God's might to uphold me, God's wisdom to guide me, God's eye to look before me, God's ear to hear me, God's word to speak for me, God's hand to guard me, God's way to lie before me, God's shield to protect me, God's host to save me, from snares of devils, from temptation of vices, from everyone who wishes me ill, afar and anear, alone and in a multitude.

I summon today all these powers between me and those evils; against every cruel merciless power that may oppose my body and soul; against incantations of false prophets; against black laws of pagandom; against false laws of heretics, against craft of idolatry, against spells of women and smiths and wizards, against every knowledge that corrupts mans body and soul.
